

# **Fraudulent Surgery Payment Nets Patient Jail Time**

An Orange County, California woman's new breasts will cost her six months in jail. Yvonne Jean Pampellonne was sentenced for using a fraudulent line of credit to obtain \$12,000 in cosmetic surgery, including breast implants and liposuction.

The 30-year-old woman pleaded guilty to burglary, grand theft and identity theft. She was sentenced to 180 days in jail and was placed on three years' probation. Restitution was also ordered, but the amount wasn't immediately clear.

Pampellonne used a line of credit established in another person's name to get the September 2008 procedures at the Pacific Center for Plastic Surgery in Huntington Beach.
