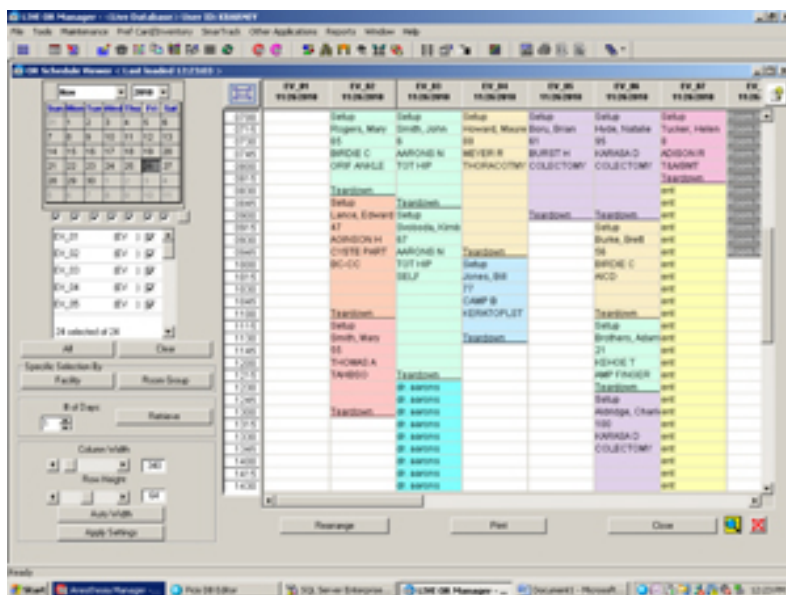

- Content Library of clinical documentation best practices for quick reference by clinicians. This reference information supports consistency and compliance of perioperative and critical care standards.
- Quality Reporting Portal, which captures and automatically analyzes hospital patient and compliance data and generates regulatory reports that demonstrate meaningful use of health information technology and adherence with national quality measures, including the Surgical Care Improvement Process (SCIP), Physician Quality Reporting Initiative (PQRI) and Joint Commission requirements. The Web-based platform makes it easy for hospital IT departments to access current information for reports.
